

Chief Secretary, GNCTD, visits the BRT Corridor



On Saturday, April 18th, 2009, the Chief Secretary, GNCTD, and the Chairman of DIMTS, Mr. Rakesh Mehta, visited the BRT corridor from Ambedkar Nagar to Moolchand to review the progress of the project.

He was accompanied by the Commissioner of Transport, GNCTD, Mr. RK Verma, the Managing Director, DIMTS, Mr. SN Sahai and the Joint Commissioner of Police (Traffic), Mr. SN Shrivastava. Also present at the visit were officials from

Mr. Mehta travelled through the corridor stopping at various points like Ambedkar Nagar, Madangiri, Chirag Delhi and Defence Colony, reviewing and discussing the various issues with the officials concerned.

Admiring the standard of cleanliness alongside the corridor, as compared to other roads, he congratulated the DIMTS team on achieving this. He further reviewed the concerns regarding the corridor, like the enforcement problems, especially with respect to unauthorized parking of cars on the pedestrian passage. He also checked the progress of the work on the foot over bridges that are coming up at various points on the corridor.
